#### Coming this Fall

This September Pastor Ron begins a multi-year teaching of The Gospel Project: A Walk Through the Entire Bible. This is a great opportunity to study the Bible from cover to cover in a classroom type setting each Wednesday night from 6:45 to 7:30. There will be handouts each week and overheads to assist with the learning. There are many reasons you should consider making a commitment to this teaching series. First, The Gospel Project gets us through the Bible. This project will get us from Genesis to Revelation, a wonderful opportunity to study the Scriptures in manageable chunks. Second, we will see the unity of Scripture. We will learn of the main themes that run through Scripture, and understand the Bible is telling one story. Third, this is a Christ-Centered approach to studying Scripture. Every verse in the Bible tells us something about the climax of salvation history, Jesus Christ. We will see how Christ is anticipated in the Old Testament and realized in the New Testament. Fourth, The Gospel Project is highly applicational and very edifying. This is not just an academic study but a devotional one as well. Fifth, Children's Ministries will be covering the same material as the adults the following Sunday morning, but in an age-appropriate fashion. This will allow parents with children to discuss the same topics at home through the week. Please consider joining us in the South Sanctuary.

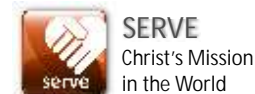

## GRIEFSHARE

August 19, 2018

### Mission & Values

After the funeral, when the cards and flowers have stopped coming, most of the people around those who are grieving return to their normal lives. But grief continues. Often, family and friends want to help but don't know how. That's the reason for GriefShare. This group is led by caring people who have experienced grief and understand the feelings accompanying grief because they have been in the same place.

GriefShare is a support group that meets weekly. In a warm, caring environment those who are grieving can come to see the group as an "oasis" on a long journey through grief. There are 13 sessions but anyone experiencing grief from the death of a loved one can begin attending the group at any point. Each session is "self-contained," so any missed sessions can be picked up during the next cycle.

### Resources

**Video Seminar** – Each week the GriefShare group will watch a video seminar featuring top experts on grief and recovery subjects. These videos are produced in an interesting television magazine format featuring expert interviews, real-life case studies, dramatic re-enactments, and on-location video.

**Support group** – After viewing the video, group members will spend time as a support group, discussing what was presented in that week's video seminar and what is going on in their lives.

**Workbook** – During the week, a workbook is available for further personal study of the grieving process and to help sort out emotions through journaling. The group will spend time discussing questions and comments from the workbook study.

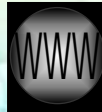
